Dear Student:

Thank you for your interest in/application to our Middle Grades Education Graduate Certification program. As you may know, that program has just recently been approved by the Pennsylvania Department of Education. We are actively recruiting students into the program, but at this point we have only a handful of interested students, which means both that we can offer only a single section of most courses and that students in our E=MC2 program, an innovative a teacher certification program designed to prepare mathematics and science professionals as middle-grade teachers, will also be taking them.

The table below details our scheduling plans for the next two years. As you can see, the program is designed to allow working professionals to complete the program in as little as 15 months and only requires a full-time commitment during the student teaching semester. Courses in this program take place during both daytime and evening hours.
